Glenn Tilbrook is one of the UK's best-loved musicians, thanks to a career with Squeeze and on his own that has spanned 30 years, spawning Top-Ten hits all around the world such as "Cool For Cats", "Tempted" and "Up The Junction". His work has been cited as a massive influence by the likes of Mark Ronson, The Feeling, Kasabian, Razorlight and Lily Allen, while last year he and his Squeeze co-writing partner Chris Difford collected both the prestigious Ivor Novello "Outstanding Contribution to British Music" and the Nordoff-Robbins "Icon" awards.

2009 has been a pretty remarkable year for Glenn so far. In March he released "Pandemonium Ensues", his first full album with The Fluffers and featuring collaborations with Johnny Depp and Vanessa Paradis, and has successfully toured the USA, Japan and of course the UK. Meanwhile, Squeeze have enjoyed another phenomenal festival season, performing at Oxegen, T in The Park and Latitude, and are looking to continue wowing audiences with a UK and US tour next year. Tilbrook and Difford have also started to write together again, with a view to releasing a brand new Squeeze album in the near future. But the most memorable moment will surely be playing an acoustic set at the top of Mount Kilimanjaro. Having already trekked to Base Camp at Everest in 2007, a feat which saw him enter the Guinness Book of Records, this year Tilbrook reunited with Love Help Strength co-founder Mike Peters (of The Alarm), as 25 musicians and cancer survivors undertook the task of raising money to help fight cancer and spread awareness in East Africa.

Now Glenn is back to the day job, and will be bringing his unpredictable solo style to fans everywhere. Known for his preference to blur the lines between spectator and performer, if previous shows are anything to go by the audience can expect to be involved in literally anything – whether it be backing vocals or even following Glenn as he beckons his crowd to leave the venue with him and set up an impromptu gig wherever he feels! After 30 years and having been to some of the highest points on Earth, Glenn Tilbrook still thrives on the buzz he gets from playing live like it was his very first time.
